1. Presentation and Updates:

Mayor Sonnentag attended and had several announcements: road construction on Old Middleton Road is set to begin in June. This coincides with phase 2 of University Avenue. Middleton was awarded 20 mature fruit and nut trees through an on-line competition from Edy's. These trees will be planted in Bock Community Gardens. Finally, representatives from the city of Middleton will be in Kansas City in June to present Middleton as a candidate for the "All American City." The All-America City Award is given by the National Civic League annually to ten cities in United States. The oldest community recognition program in the nation, the award recognizes communities whose citizens work together to identify and tackle community-wide challenges and achieve uncommon results.

County Board Supervisor Sharon Corrigan also attended the meeting and was able to share her board and commission assignments since being elected to the Dane County Board. She will serve on the Public Protection and Judiciary Committee, the UW Extension Committee, the Environmental Council and the 911 Service Commission.
